Selected Polaroids will be featured in an ongoing publication project documenting Polaroid photography. Selected photographs, photographer, and person submitting photograph will be documented in the publications. If your photograph is selected for publication you will be notified. Publications will be available for purchase on themailartproject.com and Amazon.com.

Notification of selected Polaroids and first publication date: Winter 2010.

All Polaroids will be exhibited and for sale in galleries, alternative spaces, or online. All photographs become property of The Mail Art Project and themailartproject.com. Photographs will be for sale. Proceeds from sales will benefit new and emerging artists, art education programs, and funding for art projects as selected by The Mail Art Project.

There is **NO commission** paid on any photograph or book sale to the photographer or person submitting photograph.

You are donating your Polaroid to benefit artists, art programs, art in society, and documentation of this art form.

Specifications:

- Send only **ORIGINAL POLAROID** photographs. Any Polaroid type film is accepted. Any time period is accepted. Send as many as you'd like.
- Write the photographer's name if known, and/or your name on the back of the Polaroid. Also, include any information about the photograph on front or back if desired. If your Polaroid is selected for publication the photographer's name, person submitting photograph, and/or image information will be listed. You will be notified if your photograph is published.
- All subject matter is accepted. **EXCEPTION:** No pornography, obscene, or offensive images or text may be in or on the photograph. Inoffensive nude photography is acceptable.
